Question #1

Sunday School

4th-5th

Look up Hebrews 9:22 and explain the connection between this verse and Jesus, the Lamb of God.

3. How was Epaphroditus' faith an example for the believers in Philippi?

L I F E A P P L I C A T I O N

1. Paul described Timothy as someone who sought the interests of Jesus Christ rather than himself. Timothy had a Christ-centered life.

John 15:1-11 teaches us how to have a Christ-centered life. Read this passage and discuss what it means to abide in Christ.

2. Paul described Epaphroditus as someone who was willing to give his life for the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Luke 9:23-25 teaches us what it means to lose our life for Christ. Read this passage and discuss what it means to lose your life for the gospel of Jesus Christ.
